

Visits by high officials



The three-day working visit of the Human Rights Defender of the Republic of Armenia Arman Tatoyan to Brussels organized with the joint efforts of the European Armenian Federation of Justice and Democracy and the Embassy of Armenia to Belgium. Armenia's Ombudsman had a number of meetings with high-ranking officials of the European Union.



On the joint initiative of European Armenian Federation for Justice and Democracy (EAFJD) and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Artsakh Republic, Foreign Minister Davit Babayan paid a working visit to Brussels. During his visit Babayan met with political figures in the EU and the Belgian federal government



Georges Dallemagne, a member of the Federal Parliament of Belgium and a group of Belgian journalists visited Artsakh. Dallamagne is one of the first European MPs who has visited Artsakh after the aggression unleashed on the people of Artsakh by Azerbaijan.



During his visit to Brussels, Artsakh Minister of Foreign Affairs Davit Babayan had the opportunity to speak as a guest-lecturer to students of one of the prestigious law schools in Germany. Letters and Statements

43 MEPs sent letter to Charles Michel and Josep Borrell, alerting about Azerbaijan's policy of ethnic cleansing in Nagorno Karabakh/Artsakh

EAFJD urges UNESCO and 10 other international/European cultural organisations to act and protect Armenian cultural heritage in Nagorno-Karabakh

33 MEPs call on the EU to urge Azerbaijan to withdraw forces from the Republic of Armenia

EAFJD and its committees call on the President of the European Council to reiterate EU's support for the mediation efforts of the OSCE Minsk group Co-chairs and the Basic principles, including the right to self-determination

The European Armenian Federation for Justice and Democracy (EAFJD), is a grassroots organization, representing the European citizens of Armenian origin. It is the main interlocutor promoting the Armenian issues in the European Union and international organizations, such as the Council of Europe and the OSCE.
